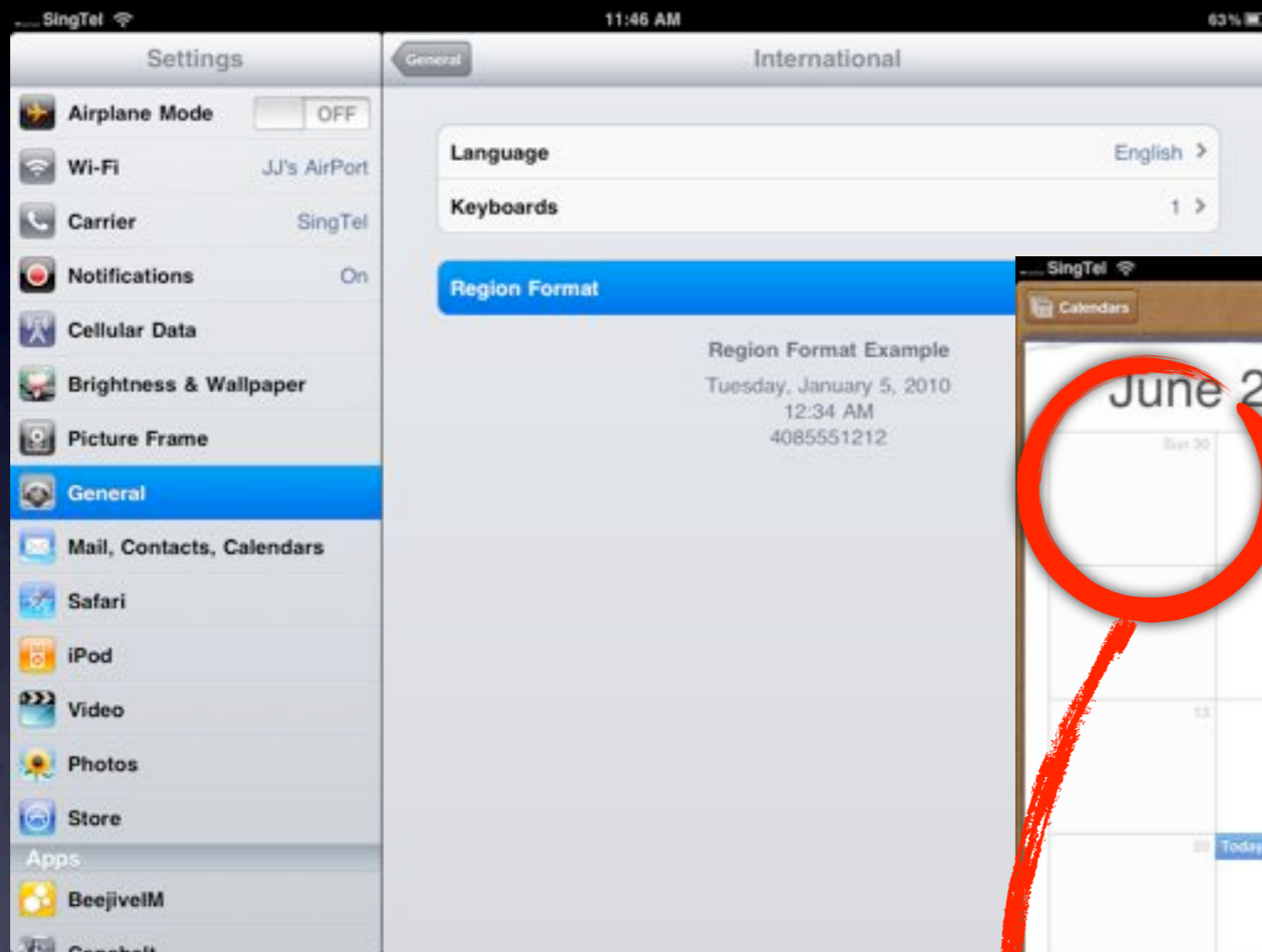


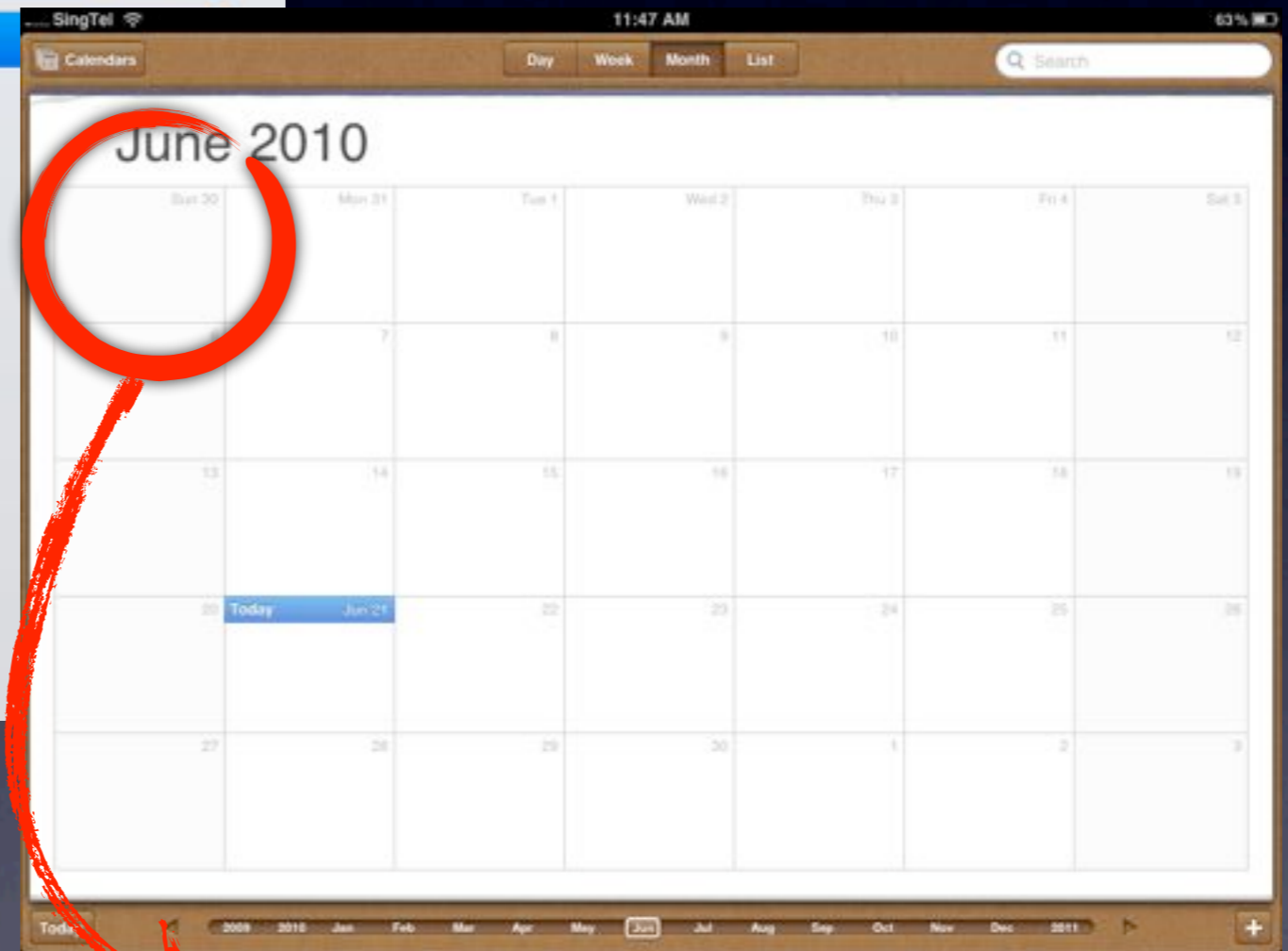

# iPad 3.2 — Problem

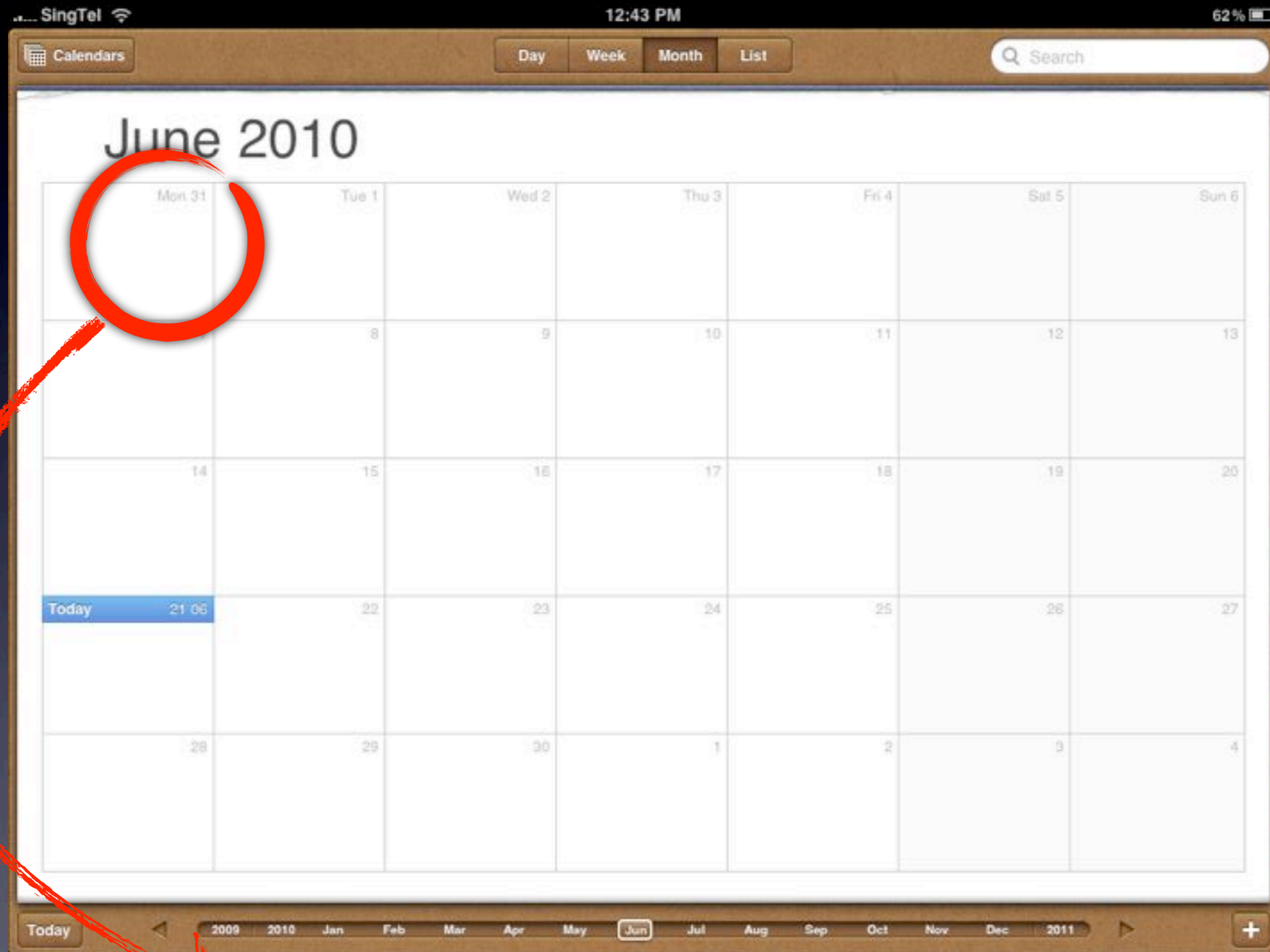


When localised to Singapore

# iPhone OS4 — Problem

# iPhone OS4 — Correct



Calendar should start week on Monday instead of Sunday when localised to Singapore

# Problem

- Singapore, a former colony of UK, adopts UK convention in many areas
- Most monthly calendars in Singapore start the week on Monday instead of Sunday
- iOS, like Mac OS X, starts the week on Sunday instead of Monday when localised to Singapore

# Problem

- However, unlike Mac OS X, iOS users have no way to get the Calendar to start week on Monday without changing region format to UK or Australia
- But using this workaround means that users will get wrongly localised results in search engines in mobile Safari



Setting Region Format to Australia to fix the calendar problem creates additional problems in searches

# Suggestions

- Not everyone in a region agrees on a standard way to display the calendar
- Instead of using *Region Format* to control this behaviour, have a separate option under *Settings > Mail, Contacts, Calendars > Calendars* for users to customise which day to start week on, as with Mac OS X's iCal
